# What are we doing each day?

Teachers send home, or email, an update on what the class has been doing each week. These initial weeks are filled with adjustments. Teachers are focusing on social emotional skills and creating a comfortable, nurturing environment. Classes are singing songs together, reading books together, playing together and learning classroom routines to foster a sense of community and comfort. It's hard for children to learn if they're worrying about how to make friends, where the bathroom is, or when they will go home. All of us are working towards easing these concerns and any others your child may have.

#### Labels

Please clearly label your child's belongings (water bottles, lunch boxes, backpacks). We sometimes have trouble matching items to their owners. Thank you!

### Allergies

We take allergies very seriously and are a peanut and tree nut free school. Please check the ingredients of any food your child may bring to school for snack or lunch. If an item contains peanuts or tree nuts or says it has been manufactured in a facility with peanut or tree nuts, it cannot come to school.

#### **Absences**

When your child is absent for any reason, please call or email to let us know the reason. If your child is sick, it is important to remember that a child must be fever free for 24 hours without medication before returning to school. This is best practice for the child as their immune system is weakened and reduces the chance of germ spread for everyone here at school. We are doing our best to keep our spaces well-ventilated, keeping windows open when possible, using our air purifiers, supervising thorough hand washing, and keeping our surfaces clean and sanitized.
